


1. Go to <https://upload.dc.gov/vpndl> and enter username and password as follows:

Username: vpndl


Password: getit

2. Click 'Juniper VPN' link


3. Click one of the 3 software to download.

4. Double click on the downloaded file to install Pulse Secure on your computer.

5. Restart the machine and launch Pulse Secure



6. Enter 'Name' and 'Server URL' as shown below and click 'Add'



8. Enter provided VPN username and password. Your VPN username should be your email address.



7. Click 'Connect' to login to VPN.



9. You will be prompted to enter a 6-digit security code. The security code will be sent to your mobile phone via text message. Please enter it and click **Connect**. Please note that you will receive a new 6 digit code each time you attempt to login. Please enter the

most recent 6 digit code to login to VPN.



10. If the 6 digit code entered is correct, then you will see a green checkmark indicating that you are successfully connected.
