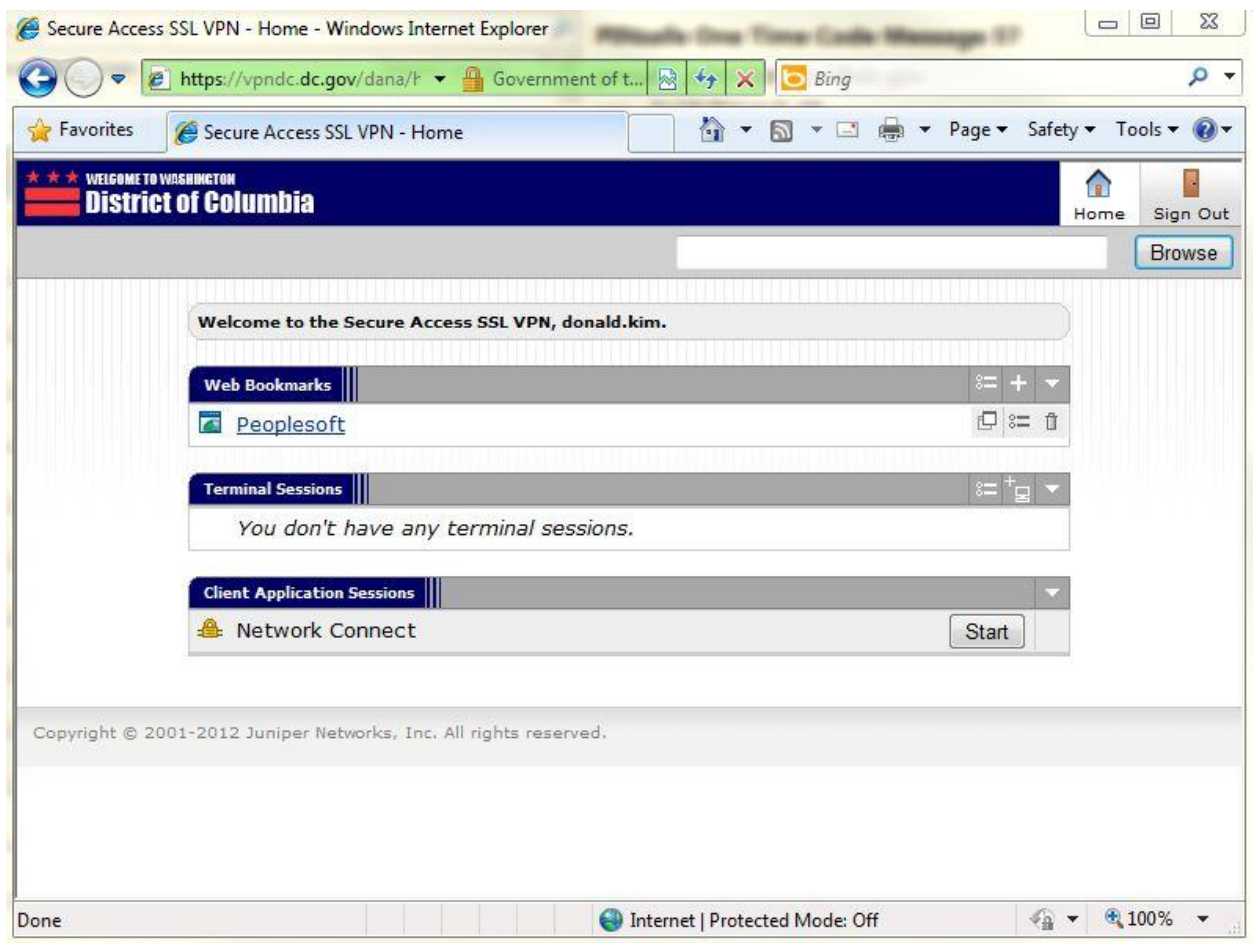
2. Enter your VPN username/password and press **Sign In**. The VPN username is your DC Government email without '@dc.gov' and the password is the same password that you use to login to your domain or to check your email. If you do not have a DC Government email, then VPN username will be sent to the email address you provided for VPN account.



3. You will be prompted to enter a 6-digit security code. The security code will be sent to your DC Government email address or to your mobile phone via text message. If you do not have a DC Government email, it will be sent to the email address you provided for VPN account. Please enter it and click **Sign In**. **Please note that you will receive a new 6 digit code each time you attempt to login. Please enter the most recent 6 digit code to login to VPN.**



4. You will see welcome screen below upon successful login.



5. You may Minimize this browser screen but DO NOT CLOSE it or your VPN session will be disconnected.
