- Question: Does OCTO offer Power BI?
 No, OCTO does not support Power BI. A few years ago, OCTO conducted a study of BI tools and centralized its services around Microstrategy and Tableau. For the foreseeable future, OCTO will be offering these solutions and not Power BI.
- Question: What is the difference between mayoral and non-mayoral
 Non-Mayoral are independent to the mayor and have a board like DC Water. Mayoral agencies are led by the mayor.
- Question: Last year there was a dashboard for the EDI. Will there be one for this year? We focused on the interface for entering the data, and this took some time. The dashboard fell by the wayside, but we will have a dashboard for next year's EDI.

- Question: Can you send the Data Report?
 We will send the link as soon as the report goes out
- Question: Have there been any conversations to facilitate exchange of data
 We have FME, informatica, Oracle, the SOA team provides audits for transactions and work the
 APIs and cloud providers. OCTO sees data exchanges as our main line of business.
 - Q. Bringing in outside jurisdictions
 - o Go outside the API gateway. Need to plan on how to exchange with other people.
- Question: Will you bring back the refreshments

- Question: Have you thought about using a Fire API?
