

1. Go to <https://upload.dc.gov/vpndl> and enter username and password as follows:

Username: vpndl

Password: getit

2. Click 'Juniper VPN' link

5. Restart the machine and launch Pulse Secure



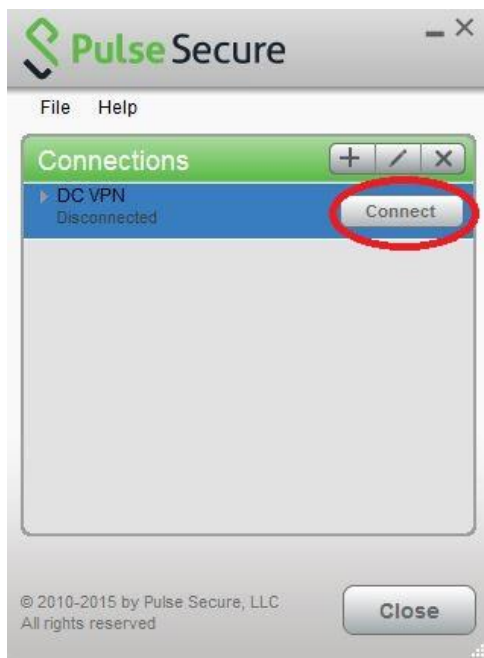
6. Enter 'Name' and 'Server URL' as shown below and click 'Add'



8. Enter provided VPN username and passcode. The VPN username is your DC Government email without '@dc.gov' and the passcode is the password that you use to login to your domain or to check your DC Government email.



7. Click 'Connect' to login to VPN.



9. You will be prompted to enter a 6-digit security code. The security code will be sent to your mobile phone via text message. Please enter it and click **Connect**. Please note that you will

receive a new 6 digit code each time you attempt to login. Please enter the most recent 6 digit code to login to VPN.



10. If the 6 digit code entered is correct, then you will see a green checkmark indicating that you are successfully connected.
