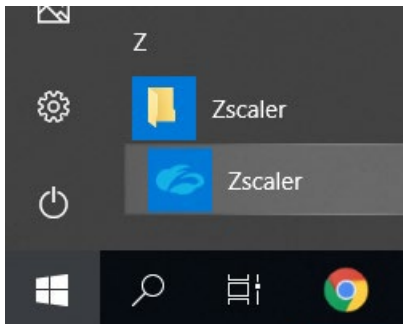
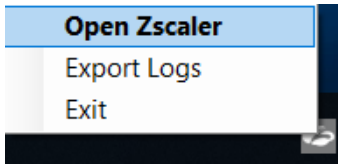

Note: If Service Status “ON” is displayed when opening Zscaler, you are connected and no further action is required.

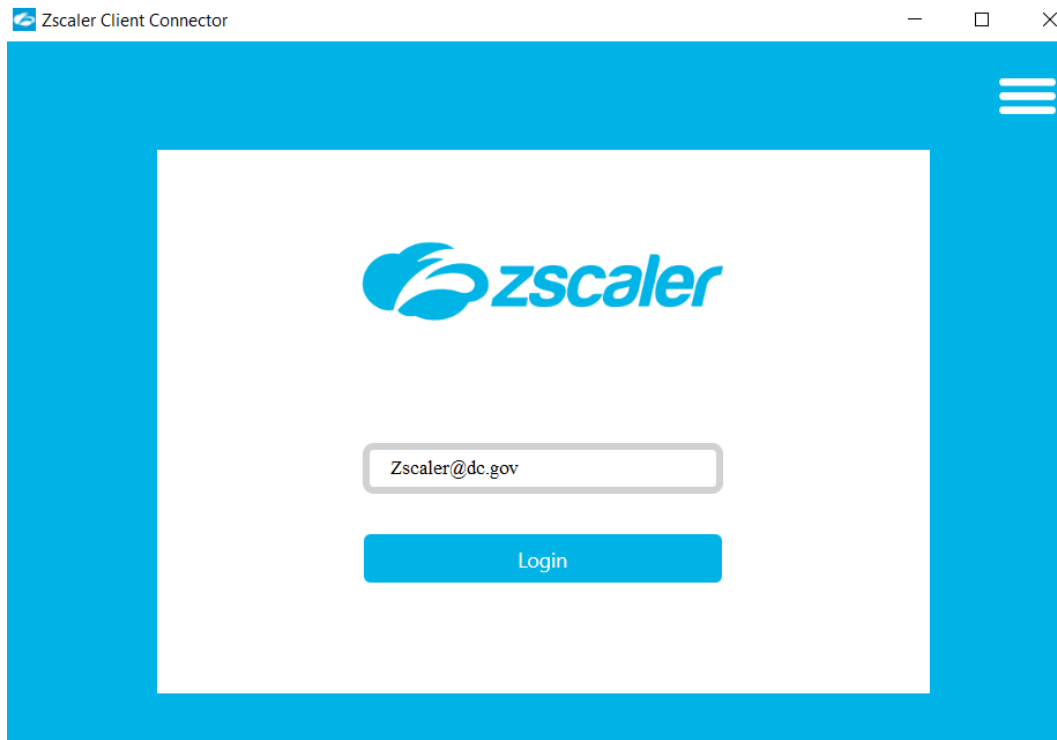

3. Once you click on the Login button it re-directs to the O365 login page. Please enter your DC GOV email password & click Sign in.



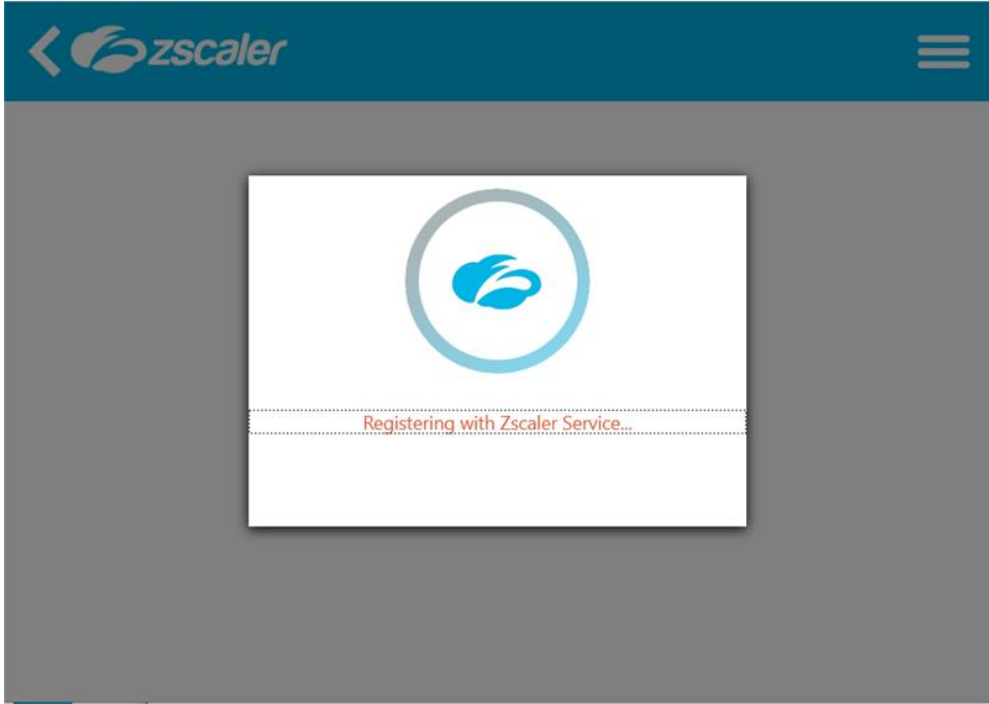
4. Click on next.
